What can Robert do next? Where is Roberto going?

Adam Gallagher reads from his new pamphlet *What can Robert do next? Where is Roberto going?*, the eighth in an ongoing series of self-published artist books. These pamphlets are produced under the umbrella acronym E.A.R.F, which can stand for, among other things: Economic Ambitions Relative Fallout, Ecological Anguish Rejects Force, Early Ancestors Risking Fate, Essential Arts Real Failure, Experimental Affinities Regained Frame, or Every Amelioration Requires Flowers. The series takes on the form of the political pamphlet, comprising text and image, loosely connected by socio-political themes. Each book attempts to process the linguistic and visual materials through which information around these issues is usually conveyed.

What can Robert do next? Where is Roberto going? is produced in an unlimited print run and will be available to buy during the event for £5. All previous books in the E.A.R.F. series will also be reprinted for the launch of this new title. The full list of E.A.R.F. publications is *What can Robert do next?
